



NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The West Fork San Jacinto River Flood Protection Study

The San Jacinto River Authority, Montgomery County, and the City of Conroe will hold the first of three public meetings on Wednesday, July 12, 2017, at 6:00 p.m., at the San Jacinto River Authority General and Administration Building, located at 1577 Dam Site Road, Conroe, Texas, 77304. The purpose of the meeting will be to discuss the flood protection study and flood early warning system project (collectively, the "Project") being conducted with respect to the West Fork San Jacinto River watershed.

The Project will update floodplain information on studied streams within Montgomery County, improve the existing hydrologic monitoring network in the County in order to enhance flood early-warning capabilities and response activities of the emergency response agencies in the region, and investigate structural and non-structural flood damage reduction projects for selected tributaries in the City of Conroe. Project findings will be summarized in a written report describing repeated problem flood areas and potential measures to mitigate future flooding. The Project is being funded by the Texas Water Development Board, the San Jacinto River Authority, Montgomery County, and the City of Conroe. The San Jacinto River Authority will provide management and administrative support services for the Project.
