- Required by EPA
- Regulated through TCEQ
- Original approval sought in 2004; expect approval in March 2018
- Includes two Programs: Interceptor and Pretreatment

Program Development Timeline

2003

- TCEQ requests survey of industrial users from SJRA

2004

- TCEQ requests SJRA to develop Program
- SJRA Program submittal to TCEQ

2005

- SJRA begins voluntary Program implementation

2013

- SJRA begins review and updates to Program documents based on regulatory changes

2015

- SJRA submits revised Program documents

2016

- TCEQ reviews submittal to finalize technical review of Program

2017

- TCEQ requests document to finalize Program approval in March 2018



Applies to all Users of the wastewater system

- 5 Industrial User Permits
- 465 Interceptor Permits

Program Enforcement

- Inspections and investigations
- Compliance Orders
 - Common - Adjusted pumping frequency
 - Common - Plumbing layout adjustment
- Water service termination
 - By retail provider usually in severe cases with public health issues
- Legal Proceedings

Program Budget

Expenses related to the Program are paid for by commercial users in The Woodlands through user permits.

Revenue

- Interceptor Permits
 - \$600 annually
- Pretreatment Permits
 - \$1,000 annually
- All sample costs passed through
