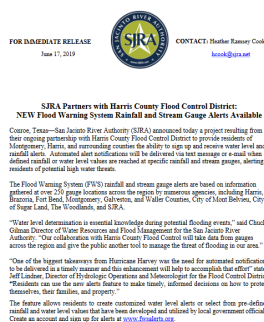




San Jacinto River Authority Latest News

The San Jacinto River Authority's mission is to develop, conserve, and protect the water resources of the San Jacinto River basin. Covering all or part of seven counties, the organization's jurisdiction includes the entire San Jacinto River watershed, excluding Harris County. The SJRA is one of two dozen river authorities in the State of Texas, and like other river authorities, its primary purpose is to implement long-term, regional projects related to water supply and wastewater treatment. SJRA receives no money from the state, nor does it collect any type of taxes.

With a few preparations ahead of time and a good check list, your family and friends will be able to enjoy Lake Conroe while keeping everyone safe and sound in the process.

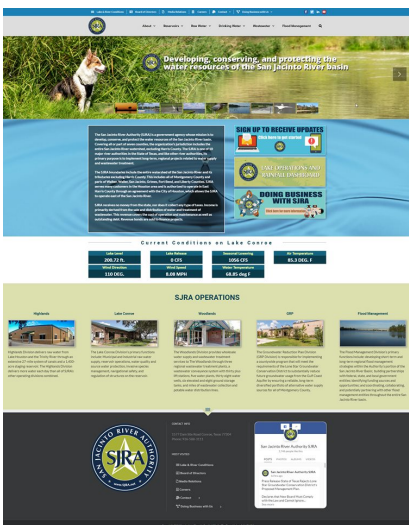
Make sure to:
