

## **Solicitation for Public Comment**

Notice is hereby given that the San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) is seeking public comment and input on the draft Community Development Block Grant – Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) scope of work, budget, and mapping to be submitted to the Texas General Land Office (GLO). The SJRA intends to apply to the Texas General Land Office's Hurricane Harvey Flood Mitigation Competition as part of the CDBG-MIT program. The selected project for application is the Caney Creek Reservoir Upstream of FM 1097, which was identified as a priority project during the San Jacinto River Regional Watershed Master Drainage Plan study.

Written and oral comments regarding the draft scope of work, budget, and mapping will be taken during a fourteen (14) day public comment period, October 8 – October 22, 2020.
