San Jacinto River Authority – GRP Division - FINAL April 19, 2021 Minutes

1. CALL TO ORDER

Chair, Mr. Mike Mooney called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

4. GRP DIVISION UPDATES

Mr. Matt Corley reviewed GRP's Monthly Operations Report highlights and provided a platform for any questions or concerns. The 8% loss in Operations Revenue is due to the weather in February and March. There have not been any billing adjustments made as a result of the freeze. Several Committee Members discussed their desire to provide the end user with some sort of compensation during weather related circumstances. Mr. Ron Kelling reminded the committee that there is not a budget for water leaks. This item will be added to a future Agenda, after the budget process is complete.

5. LONE STAR GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT REPORT

Invited Guest Speaker – Samantha Reiter, General Manager of LSGCD. Ms. Reiter shared that the GMA14 Joint Planning Group approved the following Desired Future Conditions (DFC) Statement; "In each GMA 14 county, no less than 70% median available drawdown remaining in 2080 and no more than 1 additional foot of average subsidence between 2009 and 2080". At this time the statement is not binding or final.

The GRP Review Committee met on April 12, 2021 to discuss the GRP Division's Proposed Fiscal Year 2022 Budget. Mr. Ron Kelling inquired of the interest that the GRP Review Committee Members have in reallocating the budget. Ultimately, the GRP Review Committee Members are looking for no debt impact on the rate and agreed that they would like to see these projects reallocated to bond funds in the budget.
