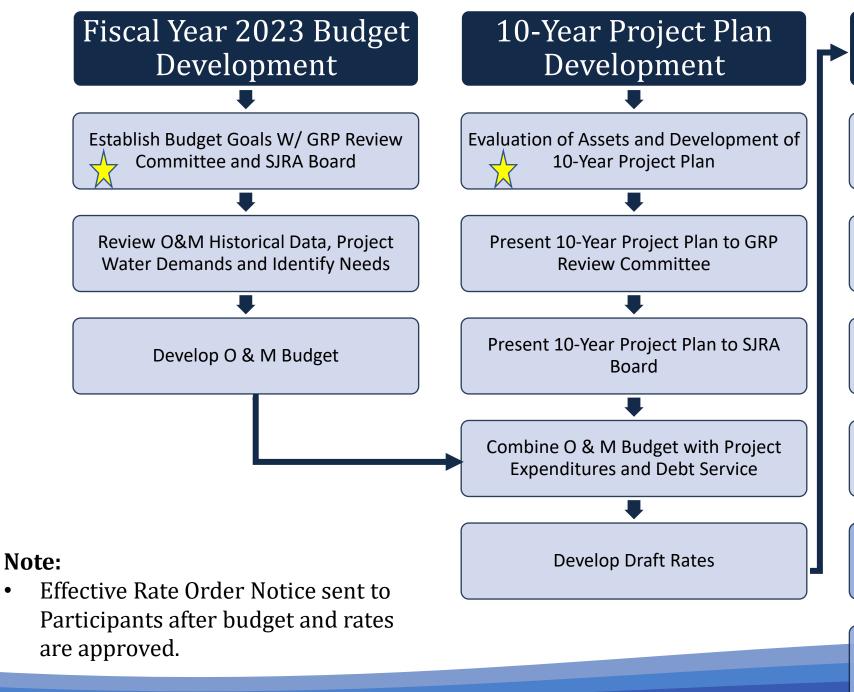

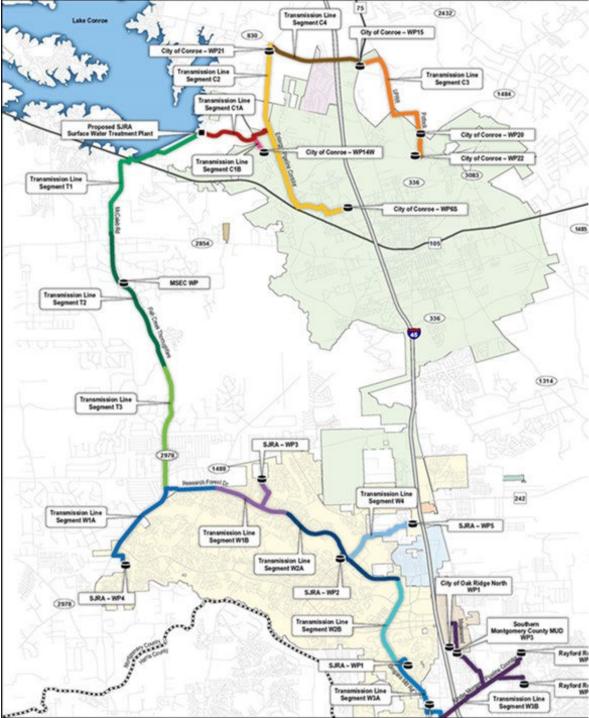

Reserve	Basis of Target Reserve Level	Minimum Target Balance
Operating & Rate Stabilization	3 Months of annual O&M budget.	\$4,600,000
Emergency	Approximate cost of water line break repair costs.	\$2,000,000
Repair & Replacement	Based on a 10-Year R&R Plan.	\$3,400,000
Total		\$10,000,000

<u>Note:</u> On July 22, 2019, the GRP Review Committee recommend approval of a Resolution confirming and creating reserve funds for GRP Division; establishing policies and procedures related to the use of such reserve funds; and establishing policy related to the sufficiency of fees, rates, and charges.
