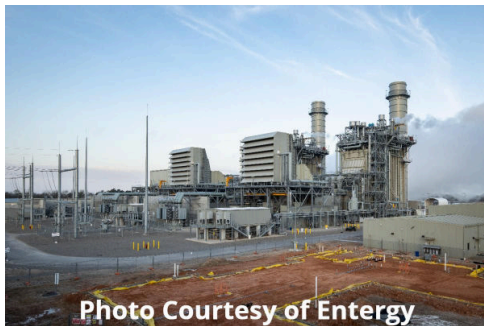

The San Jacinto River Authority (SJRA) plays a vital role as a wholesale water and wastewater service provider, serving communities, utilities, and industrial partners throughout Montgomery County and parts of Harris County. ## Water Conservation Education in Montgomery County



At home water conservation kit is pictured above. The kit consists of a number of water conservation and quality tools: rain gauge, shower timer, faucet aerator, FOG bag, dish scrapper, toilet bank, and reusable blue bag.

Tinker Water Education Program is widely used across Texas and beyond. Tinker specializes in curriculum and hands-on water education kits for 5th grade students.

A few months ago, SJRA, The Woodlands Township (Township), and the Woodlands Water Agency (WWA) launched a pilot program in The Woodlands. The pilot included one school with about 180 fifth graders. SJRA, Township, and WWA worked with Tinker to develop custom curriculum tailored to our area. If the pilot proves successful and demonstrates a strong return on investment, the program could be expanded to more 5th grade students in CISD, depending on budget availability.

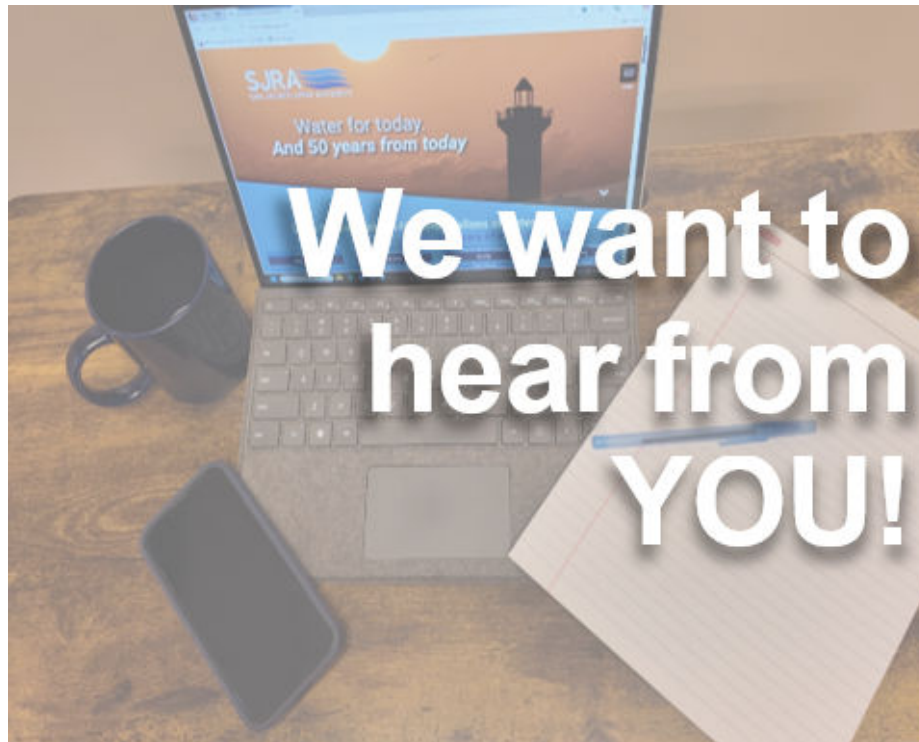

**SJRA does not have taxing authority, nor does it receive funds from the Texas Legislature.** SJRA is funded solely through contracts with its wholesale customers to provide water supply and wastewater treatment. SJRA's mission is to develop, conserve, and protect the water resources of the San Jacinto River basin. Covering all or part of seven counties, the organization's jurisdiction includes the entire San Jacinto River watershed, excluding Harris County. The SJRA is one of two dozen river authorities in the State of Texas, and like other river authorities, its primary purpose is to implement long-term, regional projects related to water supply and wastewater treatment.
